The flood hazard revisions are being proposed as part of the Letter of Map Revision (LOMR) Case No. 20-05-4952P along Middle Rouge River Walled Lake Branch.

As a result of the revision, the

- 1. The floodway will be revised from the S. Main Street Bridge to the Seven Mile Road Bridge along the Middle Rouge River Walled Lake Branch.
- 2. Base Flood Elevations (BFEs) will decrease along the Middle Rouge River Walled Lake Branch.
- 3. The Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA) will decrease along Middle Rouge River Walled Lake Branch.
